<p>Unit 1 Human Development</p> <p>External exam resit for those as needed</p>	<p>8</p>	<p>This unit has previously been assessed – resit available in January 2018. That not requiring resit work will work on an enrichment unit.</p> <p>This unit provides them with the opportunity to explore how we grow and develop throughout our lives and to investigate the factors that affect this growth and development. They will go on to consider how these factors are interrelated. There are four distinct aspects to human growth and development, usually classified as physical, intellectual, emotional and social development. These four aspects are closely related to each other, and a change in one can affect some, or all, of the other areas.</p> <p>Life events have an impact on how we grow and develop. People experience many different types of life events; some are expected and some are unexpected. Being able to manage and handle these events is an important skill in health and social care professions.</p> <p>In this unit they will explore the impact of these life events and the types of support available to help people manage them.</p> <p>Understanding and recognising the impact of these major life events is an important part of a number of roles in the health and social care sector.</p> <p>It is split into two learning aims and is assessed via a one hour exam:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> A - explore human growth and development across life stages B - investigate factors that affect human growth and development and how they are interrelated <p>This unit is worth 25% of their final grade.</p>

Unit 2 Care Values development	18	<p>This unit was delivered in year 9, as theory but now in year 11 the work is to be developed so that learners have the chance to achieve all grades they are able to.</p> <p>Learning aims: A - explore the care values that underpin current practice in health and social care B - investigate ways of empowering individuals who use health and social care services.</p> <p>This unit is worth 25% of their final grade. It is assessed via controlled assessment coursework.</p>
Unit 3 Effective communication development	16	<p>This unit was delivered in year 9, as theory but now in year 11 the work is to be developed so that learners have the chance to achieve all grades they are able to.</p> <p>Learning aims: A - investigate different forms of communication B - investigate barriers to communication in health and social care C - communicate effectively in health and social care.</p> <p>This unit is worth 25% of their final grade. It is assessed via controlled assessment coursework.</p>
Enhancement unit	10	<p>This unit compliments all of the work done to date in the course and will focus on the real life job market and include activities such as visits to post 16 provisions and employers.</p> <p>Whilst this unit has no credit to count towards their final grade it will enhance their overall knowledge and prepare them for entering Health and Social care at level 3 should they wish to after leaving Byrchall High School.</p>
