## Arrival:

- School is open from 7.30am, the side gate will be open for you.
- Pupil reception is open from 7.45 am .
- If you arrive by bike there is a new lockable bike shed you can use.
- If you arrive after 8.30 am you will enter via pupil reception.

## Corridors and stairs:

- Our new corridors are light, bright and full of space.

- Line up outside classrooms in single file.

## Warning bell before registration:

Movement in The Restaurant:
There will be two separate queves for break and lunch, these are shown by the green arrows. One queue is for upper school and one is for lower school. Both serving hatches serve exactly the same food.

In order to be served as quickly as possible queves will be single file and bags will not be allowed in the restaurant.
