



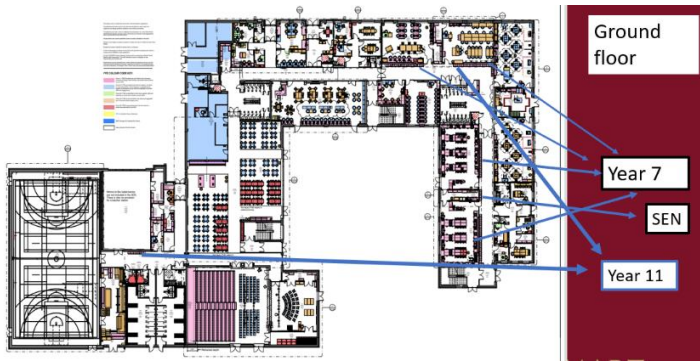
NEW SCHOOL NEW START NEW YOU!

LOCKERS

Every student will be allocated a locker with a key in our new building. There will be CCTV on each locker block. Your locker location will change each year as you progress through the years in school. You will be able to decorate the inside of your locker.



LOCATIONS



There will be lockers on all three floors of the new building. On the ground floor, they will be for Year 7, SEN students and some Year 11 student leaders. On the first floor, there will be lockers for Year 8, Year 9 and Year 10. On the second floor, the rest of Year 11 will have their lockers.

- Mobile phone
- School bag
- Coat
- PE kit
- Exercise books
- Calculator
- Footballs



THINK SMART | LOOK SMART | BE SMART

There will be no need to carry your school bag, coat and mobile phone around school as they will be placed in your lockers at the beginning of the day. You will also store your PE kit in your locker. You will be able to pick up the books you need for lessons either before school, at break or at the end of lunch.

You will only need to carry around school, your books for 2 lessons at a time, your pencil case and your PE bag (if needed). In September, you will be given a Byrchall PE bag and pencil case filled with essential equipment. Mobile phones will be switched off and stay in your locker all day (unless you have an agreed medical exemption).

ACCESS

You will be able to access your locker at the following times:

- Warning bell before registration -8.20am
- Before registration (drop off belongings and pick up books for periods 1 and 2)
- Break (books for periods 3 and 4)
- Lunch (return books)
- Warning bell at the end of lunch -1.50pm (books for period 5)
- End of day (pick up belongings)

LOCKER ETIQUETTE

You will be expected to look after your locker and use it sensibly and responsibly. There should be:

- No external decoration (although you can decorate the inside of your locker)
- No loitering in the area (be polite and respectful to others accessing their locker)
- No food left in your locker
- Take responsibility for your key and keep it safe (replacement keys will cost £5)



You should leave your locker as you found it at the end of the year. You will be allocated a new locker each year as you progress through the school. There will be rewards for the best kept lockers in each year group.
